Dear Colleagues, dear Friends of the Medical Section!

During the Christmas Conference Rudolf Steiner described how human beings in earlier times of the earth's development, before they entered condensed earthly existence, encompassed the whole earth as widely extended, etheric-cosmic beings. In doing so, they initially carried the entire plant world within them in a watery air-like state, only to separate it from themselves as they progressed in their development and — as messengers of the gods — carry it from the cosmic surroundings to the earth. "Humans felt as though they had surrounded the Earth with the garment of plant growth [...] and as though the Earth were thankful for this enfolding [...]." (CW 233, p. 68). There was an intimate relationship be-

tween human beings and the earth, mediated by the plant world — as an image of comprehensive primal health. The knowledge of this meant that in earlier cultures a moral element always resonated in the **relationship with nature**. A naked natural science with often destructive consequences and without an inner moral relationship with nature would have been unimaginable.

At the Research Congress of the Medical Section at the Goetheanum from 8–10 March, Astrid van Zon reported on how our current alienation from nature is inextricably linked to mental illnesses such as loneliness, social anxiety and loss of meaning. Conversely, a living relationship with nature sus-

tainably promotes mental and physical health ("green mental health") and increases resilience, independence and the ability to build relationships.

When we are looking for a medicinal plant for a medical condition, the memory of the intimate relationship of the human being to the plant world at the beginning of the time on earth also resonates. The healing forces lie hidden in this relationship. But they are "spellbound" in today's earthly conditions and must be liberated again by appropriate pharmaceutical processes, such as the homoeopathic potentisation process for example, in order to awaken the healing powers that lie dormant within them. It is moral forces that the therapist and pharmacist combine with the correspondingly processed medicinal plant so that the spiritual forces of the plant can be revealed. As the patient overcomes their illness through the medicine to attain new health, nature has also been raised to a higher, future level in the medicine.

In his opera *Parsifal*, which will be performed at the Goetheanum again this Easter, Richard Wagner lets this "resurrection process" of nature through the human being resound in the "Good Friday Spell":

"Now all of creation does rejoice at the Redeemer's loving trace, wanting to consecrate its prayer to Him. Him on the cross it cannot behold: so looks up to the human redeemed [...]"

A completely new "One Health concept" can thus be formed that does not stem from fear of nature, but from love for it. This will hopefully give us the enthusiasm to continue to stand up for our medicinal products in the future.

Gratifyingly, an unprecedented collective effort in Germany succeeded in collecting even more than the required 50,000 signatures for the petition against the removal of homoeopathy and anthroposophic medicine from the health insurance catalogue of benefits, so that the Petitions Committee should deal with the issue.

Alongside this, however, a further threat calling into question homoeopathy and anthroposophic medicine is already looming at European level in the course of the current revision of European pharmaceutical legislation — with far-reaching consequences should this come to pass. Here, too, the pharmaceutical manufacturers and the medical associations in close cooperation with academics (special thanks go to Dr med Harald Hamre and his team) are undertaking intensive preparatory work.

Dietrich von Bonin, Franziska Schmidt-von Nell, Esther Bött-cher, Jan-Gabriel Niedermeier: Therapeutische Sprachgestaltung. Theorie und Praxis einer anthroposophischen Kunsttherapie, Berlin 2024. This book presents a comprehensive overview of the indications and principles of action as well as the practical application

of therapeutic speech. It deals with the background and professional occupational standards as well as the current state of research with extensive references. The interventions, which have often been tried and tested over decades, can be accessed for the first time in over 100 videos directly via QR codes, making this work a reliable companion for prescribing, practising and teaching.



Dagmar Brauer, Matthias Girke (Eds): Anthroposophische Maltherapie. Grundlagen – Indikationen – Durchführung, Berlin 2024.

Thirty-five authors provide their expertise here for the growing relevance of painting and drawing therapy in medicine (practice and clinic), special needs education, social therapy and

rehabilitation. This work presents the basic principles, methods and techniques of painting and drawing and describes their application, indications and efficacy from the perspective of the anthroposophical understanding of the human being. A large number of examples from practical work – with over 320 colour illustrations – help to find effective treatment paths for patients and clients. It is aimed at people who are training in art therapy or who want to deepen and expand their art therapy work, as well as physicians, psychologists and other therapists who prescribe or use art therapy.


